- As Congressional Research Service (then LRS) specialist (1941-1975), advised Congress on space policy and law, helping to write the 1958 NASA Act, e.g. Helped found IISL and IAA Section 4.
- Committed to:
 - International Cooperation
 - Maintaining space for peaceful purposes
 - Human Exploration of the Solar System
- Author of more than 100 publications on space law and policy
- The "Grand Dame" of U.S. space policy and law




